

Dear Guest,

We welcome you and your pet to the Concord's Colonial Inn. Monument Square, our backyard patio, and the adjacent walking trails are wonderful places to walk your pet. The Town of Concord requires that all pets be on a leash at all times. Additionally, the pet owner is responsible for clean-up of any waste. There are a few rules for pets at Concord's Colonial Inn, please read below carefully:

- We allow up to 2 pets in each room.
- Should there be any damage to the room or disturbance to other guests as a result of the actions of your pet, we reserve the right to bill you for the cost of restoration of the room or compensation made to other guests.
- Your pet cannot join you in our restaurants, taverns, or any of the meeting or banquet rooms.
- This includes the Front Porch Patio as it is an active restaurant area.
- Your pet must be on a leash and in your control whenever they are out of your room.
- Your pet must not be left unattended at any time to the degree the pet becomes a disturbance to staff or other guests. There are a number of local dog daycare, pet sitting, and dog walking services available locally.
- With regards to housekeeping services, our staff will not service your room unless your pet has been removed. If you would like to request housekeeping service at a designated time, please advise the front desk staff. If no such time was arranged and the staff could not access the room, fresh towels, linens and amenities may be requested at a later time.
- You are responsible for the actions of your pet. Should the animal create a disturbance for our guests and you cannot be reached, we reserve the right to contact the local humane society and have your pet removed from the Inn. Any cost involved will be at your own responsibility.
- A charge of \$35 per night has been applied to your room. This is non-refundable and covers the cost of additional cleaning required during and after your stay.

We hope that both you and your pet enjoy your stay with us, and your visit to Concord.
